Teaching methods	The course sessions alternate between lectures and interactive moments (exercises, discussions, case studies) organized in such a way that the students mobilize and appropriate the concepts presented in the course. Theoretical presentations alternate with practical exercises throughout the course.				
Content	This teaching unit consists of a series of theoretical presentations introducing students to evolutions with regard to the modes of regulation and evaluation practices of educational organizations, as well as to the main concepts that allow for an analytical look at these issues.
