Learning outcomes	<p><b>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Provide a foundation course in Dutch phonetics, phonology and morphology. The students should also be able to analyse reference books with a criticizing mind.</li> </ol>
Evaluation methods	<p>Oral examination in the June and August/September session</p> <p>The final grade of the course will be the average of the following three grades:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- one grade out of 20 for the 'morphology' part</li> <li>- one grade out of 20 for the 'phonetics/phonology' part</li> <li>- one grade out of 20 for the oral command of the language (pronunciation [segmental and suprasegmental levels], grammar, lexicon)</li> </ul>
Teaching methods	Mixed approach of lectures, reading of scientific articles and exercises.
Content	<p>The course is an introduction to Dutch phonetics, phonology and morphology.</p> <p>Phonetics and phonology (vowels, diphthongs, consonants; co-articulation; accentuation and intonation).</p> <p>Morphology (especially lexical morphology, loanwords and neologisms).</p>
