Prerequisites	None
Learning outcomes	
Evaluation methods	The evaluation combines (1) the opinion of the tutor (25%) and (2) the 10-page philological research work (75%).
Teaching methods	Practical training supported by an internship supervisor and writing of the scientific work under the supervision of the dissertation promoter.
Content	The internship can be carried out in a museum, an archaeological deposit, on an excavation site, etc. Excursions are excluded, but it is possible to participate in the active guidance of a two-week stay in Egypt. In all cases, the course consists of work on textual sources or on a group of objects requiring philological study. This work must also be combined with a contextualized study of the material supports of the inscriptions or the texts studied.
