| Teaching methods            | Regular interaction with the promoter. These meetings can be collective if several students are working on a similar topic (seminar format). The meetings will be held in the language of the work, either English, German, Dutch, Spanish, Italian or French.  |  |  |  |
| Content                     | The student chooses a topic that he/she develops and deepens in a personal and original way for a scientific research work at the end of the bachelor's degree. This topic is related to questions and problems in literature, linguistics or cultural studies of the languages of specialization. He/she will write a paper on the chosen topic in agreement with his/her promoter.<br>The body of the TFC, excluding appendices, tables and bibliography, is approximately 30,000 characters including spaces (13 to 15 pages). |  |  |  |
