Written exam in January and September. Evaluation methods - Ex-cathedra lectures given by the professor. The content is mainly theoretical, with some involvement of the Teaching methods students required and Q&A sessions. Attendance is mandatory. - Tutorials for the law students, supervised by the assistant. The tutorials will be given online. The course is divided into three parts. The first part is devoted to the historical, politico-legal, institutional and Content ideological foundations of the European Union. The institutional context of the EU and its decision-making process will be analysed in the second part.
