Evaluation methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written exam comprising a range of question formats.</li> <li>• MCQs (multiple choice, matching exercises, True-False), possibly eliminatory.</li> <li>• Messages to complete.</li> <li>• Grammar translation from A to B.</li> <li>• Conjugation practice.</li> <li>• Integrated summative assessment (written exam) at the end of the term in which a topic has been studied.</li> </ul> <p>Q 1 is worth 30% and Q 2 is worth 70%.</p>
Teaching methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Group correction and tutor's analysis and commentary on exercises completed by students in advance of classes.</li> <li>• Preparation before (i.e. away from) classes and active participation in class is required.</li> </ul>
Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Elementary grammar focusing on the verb phrase, the noun phrase, the adverb, the preposition and the conjunction.</li> <li>• Practical applied language tasks designed to ensure that on completing the course students have a command of the basic language functions as set out in the 'European Reference Framework for Languages' (level A - Writing). Study of Spanish spelling rules.</li> </ul>
