Learning outcomes	<b>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</b> On completing this Unit students should be able to: 1. Recognise these basic Italian grammatical mechanisms in any form of text/speech; 2. Apply these mechanisms both in the spoken and the written language as well as in exercises similar to those undertaken in class.
Evaluation methods	Written and oral continuous assessment represents 25 % of the final mark for each Module, which conclude with a written exam. Module 1 has a value of 2 credits; Module 2 has a value of 3 credits.
Teaching methods	Lectures and in-class exercises.
Content	Module 1: morphology of articles, nouns and adjectives; the verb: present indicative (including reflexive verbs), perfect and future tenses. Introduction to Italian phonetics. Module 2: pronouns; comparatives and superlatives; the verb: the imperfect (indicative), conditional, present and imperfect subjunctives; introduction to compound sentences.
