Main themes	This course intends to develop the conceptual, critical and methodological skills of a selection of important diagnostic tests in the clinical field.

Teaching methods	The lectures will be based on the analysis of test protocols of clinical cases. The main goal is the development the student's critical thinking about tests. Students are expected to work between the main lectures, especially during the practical sessions.
Content	To develop the student's critical thinking about the use of the psychodiagnostic tests, tests from different domains will be analyzed.
