Evaluation methods	The course assessment aims to measure the achievement of the intended learning outcomes. This assessment will consist of three small assignments: the first involves briefly presenting a case study (5 points), the second involves preparing to discuss the limitations of the case study approach (5 points), and the third assignment entails proposing a case study based on a specific research question (10 points). You will need to describe the theoretical context, the study's design, the statistical analyses, and present possible study results and their interpretation.
