CRIM1PM - Admission

For the specific conditions of this program : refer to the French version

(Decree of March 31st 2004 defining higher education, favoring its integration in the European framework of higher education and refinancing universities)

The admission requirements must be met prior to enrolment in the university.

General conditions

Access to the preparatory year on the basis of a bridging programme:

- Access to the preparatory year for students who have a [non-university "short-type" higher education degree](#)
- Access to the preparatory year for students who have a [non-university "long-type" higher education degree](#)

Upon completion of the Master's admission procedure , students may be required to take extra courses representing a maximum of 60 additional credits. Where the extra workload exceeds 15 credits, this training is considered to be a preparatory year of study.

- **Access to the preparatory year on the basis of [accreditation of prior learning and skills acquired through personal or professional experience](#)** :

Article 53 of the Decree of 30 March 2004 stipulates that: *"Notwithstanding article 51, without prejudice to article 60, and in accordance with a decision by the academic authorities, for the purpose of granting access to Master's studies, the competent Examination Board may accredit prior learning and skills acquired by students through their personal or professional experience. This useful experience must correspond to at least five years of activities, excluding years of higher education study that were not passed. At the end of an assessment procedure organized by the academic authorities, the Examination Board will decide whether a student has sufficient knowledge and skills to successfully pursue Master's studies."*

- **Access to the preparatory year on the basis of accreditation of 180 ECTS credits by the Admissions Board (personalized admission based on application)** for students who have a degree from a Belgian university or qualifications obtained abroad (which do not give access to this particular year on the basis of the abovementioned general conditions).

In the event of the divergence between the different linguistic versions of the present conditions, the French version shall prevail

Learning outcomes

L'année de formation préparatoire au Master en criminologie a pour objectif de donner aux étudiants de l'enseignement supérieur hors université les pré-requis en droit, psychologie, sociologie et langues qui sont nécessaires pour suivre le Master en criminologie. Elle les introduit à l'étude du crime, de la déviance, de la marginalité et du contrôle social et en les initiant aux disciplines de bases de la criminologie.

Evaluation

Chaque cours du programme comporte un examen oral ou écrit, éventuellement complété par un projet conduisant à un rapport intervenant dans l'évaluation. Les travaux personnels et les exercices pratiques du programme favorisent une évaluation continue. Le séminaire de méthodologie du travail universitaire en criminologie initie plus particulièrement les étudiants à la recherche de documents bibliographiques et à la rédaction d'un travail personnel de niveau universitaire.
