### Learning outcomes

Psychologists are required to develop and apply knowledge, practices, models and methods of psychology, within an ethical and scientific framework, in order to promote the development, the well-being, perhaps even the efficiency of individuals, groups, organizations or society.

The Master programme is therefore focused on developing skills in the following fields : knowledge of the discipline, interpersonal and professional relationships, methods for diagnosis and assessment, intervention with the aim of re-establishing optimal behaviour, ethically sound attitude and knowledge of the legal structures in which the profession works, effective and appropriate communication, professional development (continuous updating of knowledge and skills).

On successful completion of this programme, each student is able to :
