Introduction

The bachelor's degree in translation and interpreting is a first-cycle programme which introduces students to other languages and cultures, opens them up to the world and deepens their knowledge of French – language A in the programme – and of two foreign languages from a dozen language combinations. At the start of year 2, students may add introductory courses in a third foreign language.

The faculty offers two streams for students to choose from: a traditional translation and interpreting programme or an intercultural communication programme.

- **Translation and interpreting programme**

At the end of the bachelor's degree, you will have mastered the written and oral communication skills needed to render a foreign language in French, whether translating written texts or interpreting speeches (consecutive interpreting). During the programme – which is based on professional practice – you will be encouraged to reflect on the evolution of the profession with respect to new technologies, and to discover different translation tools. An exchange programme with a foreign university will also enable you to gain a better understanding of the culture of the country whose language you are studying.

- **Intercultural communication programme**

At the end of the bachelor's degree, you will have mastered written and oral communication in the two foreign languages of your language combination, and will have developed advanced skills in French. During the programme, you will be introduced to intercultural communication from an interdisciplinary perspective. You will discover the subtleties of communication in multicultural environments.

In both programmes, an exchange with a foreign university will also enable you to gain a better understanding of the culture of the country whose language you are studying.

Your future job

The translation and interpreting programme is divided into two cycles: the three-year bachelor's degree and the two-year master's degree. After completing a master's degree in translation and interpreting, there are many and varied career opportunities, both in Belgium and abroad:

- you may work as a freelance translator or for a translation agency, a company or a Belgian, European or international institution such as the UN or NATO
- you may work in a wide variety of fields: the media, the social and non-profit sector, tourism, culture and events, diplomacy, financial institutions, business, marketing, public relations, education, publishing, human resources, etc.
- you will be required to keep pace with developments in the profession linked to NICT and AI such as machine translation, post-editing, subtitling and localisation

The intercultural communication programme allows you to access [other master's degrees](#), including multilingual communication, journalism, international relations, etc.

Your programme

The translation and interpreting programme at Saint-Louis - Bruxelles is based on three main areas: foreign languages, French and general education.

You will not just be studying the subtleties of French and the other languages you have chosen. In the translation and interpreting programme, you will also take courses in law, economics, the history of international relations, literature, French stylistics, etc. In the intercultural communication programme, you will take courses in communication science, organisational communication, intercultural relations and sociology. This solid background will enable you to better understand the world and participate actively in communication between cultures.

The Saint-Louis faculty of translation and interpreting offers you:

- **a dynamic network of partners in Belgium and around the world:** in year 3, you will have the opportunity to take part of your programme (25 credits) at a partner university

- **a chance to study a third language:** you can add a third language (15 credits) to your bachelor's programme as soon as you have obtained the 60 credits in year 1
- **a specific programme for German-speaking students**

- A perfect command of language A (mother tongue): the ability to use the language with a very high level of precision, both orally and in writing, in order to convey all the subtleties of meaning
- The ability to work from two (foreign) C languages and achieve a level of authenticity equivalent to that of a native speaker in oral and written comprehension
- The skills needed to put theory into practice
- The ability to structure and update language skills
- The ability to convey the message of the source text (oral or written) in another language

Programme structure

The bachelor's degree in translation and interpreting is a first-cycle programme consisting of 180 credits spread over three years (60 credits in year 1, year 2 and year 3). There are two streams for students to choose from: a traditional translation and interpreting programme or an intercultural communication programme.

Translation and interpreting programme

The programme covers three main areas:

1. **The French language:** translation and interpreting are carried out from the foreign language into French, which students have a perfect command of. The programme therefore places great emphasis on perfecting French language skills through many courses spread over the three years of the bachelor's degree.
2. **Foreign languages:** the aim is to acquire a thorough knowledge of at least two other languages. A large part of the programme is therefore devoted to practising foreign languages, discovering cultures and learning about translation and interpreting.
3. **General education:** translation and interpreting require a solid general education at university level. For example, introductory courses in law, economics, sociology and new linguistic technologies help students to enrich their general knowledge.

Intercultural communication programme

The programme covers three main areas:

1. **The French language:** translation and interpreting are carried out from the foreign language into French, which students have a perfect command of. The programme therefore places great emphasis on perfecting French language skills through many courses spread over the three years of the bachelor's degree.

2. **Foreign languages:** the aim is to acquire a thorough knowledge of at least two other languages. A large part of the programme is therefore devoted to practising foreign languages, discovering cultures and learning about translation and interpreting.

3. **Introduction to communication sciences:** the aim is to provide a background in communication in multicultural contexts. Courses in communication sciences, organisational communications and sociology – some of which can be taken in English or Dutch – provide students with knowledge and skills in communication.

Courses in oral and written language, grammar, translation and interpreting are offered in all language combinations.

Some languages require prior knowledge: English and Dutch courses are based on secondary school prerequisites. The Saint-Louis - Bruxelles campus offers summer preparatory courses in these two languages.

No prerequisites are required for the other languages, for which beginners' courses are offered. For German and Spanish, students will be divided into groups based on a language test taken at the start of the academic year.

At the end of the bachelor's programme, students will have acquired a thorough knowledge of the two foreign languages chosen, a command of the subtleties of the French language and solid general knowledge. They will be well prepared for their future career.

Specific programme for German-speaking students

As a German speaker, a specific programme is available to you if you choose English and German. The programme includes practice courses in French grammar for German speakers and gives them the opportunity to translate from French into German in a large part of the translation courses. These courses are taught by French- and German-speaking professors.

You may also take part in an [ERASMUS exchange](#) in a German-speaking country or many other destinations – including France and the United Kingdom – in order to perfect your knowledge of another language in your language combination.

Introduction to the study of a third foreign language

After acquiring the 60 credits in year 1, students may add introductory courses in a third foreign language in addition to their bachelor's degree. This means that you are able to add 15 credits to your programme, which will be listed in the annex to your diploma. This represents a true asset for your future academic and professional career.

- require the student to combine registration in two separate CUs which it considers necessary from a pedagogical point of view.
- transform a prerequisite into a corequisite if the student is in the final year of a degree course.

TIMB1BA - Information

Access Requirements

Decree of 7 November 2013 defining the landscape of higher education and the academic organization of studies.

The admission requirements must be met prior to enrolment in the University.

In the event of the divergence between the different linguistic versions of the present conditions, the French version shall prevail.

General access requirements

Except as otherwise provided by other specific legal provisions, admission to undergraduate courses leading to the award of a Bachelor's degree will be granted to students with one of the following qualifications :

1. A Certificate of Upper Secondary Education issued during or after the 1993-1994 academic year by an establishment offering full-time secondary education or an adult education centre in the French Community of Belgium and, as the case may be, approved if it was issued by an educational institution before 1 January 2008 or affixed with the seal of the French Community if it was issued after this date, or an equivalent certificate awarded by the Examination Board of the French Community during or after 1994;
2. A Certificate of Upper Secondary Education issued no later than the end of the 1992-1993 academic year, along with official documentation attesting to the student's ability to pursue higher education for students applying for a full-length undergraduate degree programme;
3. A diploma awarded by a higher education institution within the French Community that confers an academic degree issued under the above-mentioned Decree, or a diploma awarded by a university or institution dispensing full-time higher education in accordance with earlier legislation;
4. A higher education certificate or diploma awarded by an adult education centre;
5. A pass certificate for one of the [entrance examinations](https://uclouvain.be/fr/etudier/inscriptions/examens-admission.html) (<https://uclouvain.be/fr/etudier/inscriptions/examens-admission.html>) organized by higher education institutions or by an examination board of the French Community; this document gives admission to studies in the sectors, fields or programmes indicated therein;
6. A diploma, certificate of studies or other qualification similar to those mentioned above, issued by the Flemish Community of Belgium, the German Community of Belgium or the Royal Military Academy;
7. A diploma, certificate of studies or other qualification obtained abroad and deemed equivalent to the first four mentioned above by virtue of a law, decree, European directive or international convention;

Note:

Requests for equivalence must be submitted to the Equivalence department ([Service des équivalences](#)) of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the French Community of Belgium in compliance with the official deadline.

The following two qualifications are automatically deemed equivalent to the Certificate of Upper Secondary Education (Certificat d'enseignement secondaire supérieur – CESS):

- European Baccalaureate issued by the Board of Governors of a European School,
- International Baccalaureate issued by the International Baccalaureate Office in Geneva.

8. Official documentation attesting to a student's ability to pursue higher education (diplôme d'aptitude à accéder à l'enseignement supérieur - DAES), issued by the Examination Board of the French Community.

Specific access requirements

- Access to bachelor programmes for candidates of nationality outside the European Union who are not assimilated to Belgian nationals is subject to the following criteria:
 - not have obtained a secondary education diploma for more than 3 years maximum. Example: for an admission application for the academic year 2023-2024, you must have obtained your diploma during the academic years 2020-2021, 2021-2022 ou 2022-2023. In the French Community of Belgium, the academic year runs from September 14 to September 13
 - not already hold an undergraduate degree
- Candidates, whatever their nationality, with a secondary school diploma **from a country outside the European Union**, must have obtained an average of 13/20 minimum or, failing that, have obtained this average, have passed one year of study in Belgium (for example special Maths / sciences). A non-successful year will not be taken into consideration.

- For any secondary school diploma **from a European Union country**, the admission request must contain the equivalence of your diploma or, at the very least, proof of the filing of the equivalence request with the Wallonia-Brussels Federation (French Community of Belgium). For any information relating to obtaining an equivalence, please refer to [the following site](#).
- For any secondary school diploma **from a country outside the European Union**, the admission application must contain the [equivalence of your diploma](#) issued by the Wallonia-Brussels Federation (French Community of Belgium). If you have a restrictive equivalence for the programme of your choice, in addition of it, you **must** have either the **DAES** or a certificate of successful completion of the [examination giving access to 1st cycle studies](#) when you submit your application

Access based on validation of professional experience

Admission to undergraduate studies on the basis of accreditation of knowledge and skills obtained through professional or personal experience (Accreditation of Prior Experience)

Subject to the general requirements laid down by the authorities of the higher education institution, with the aim of admission to the undergraduate programme, the examination boards accredit the knowledge and skills that students have obtained through their professional or personal experience.

This experience must correspond to at least five years of documented activity, with years spent in higher education being partially taken into account: 60 credits are deemed equivalent to one year of experience, with a maximum of two years being counted. At the end of an assessment procedure organized by the authorities of the higher education institution, the Examination Board will decide whether a student has sufficient skills and knowledge to successfully pursue undergraduate studies.

After this assessment, the Examination Board will determine the additional courses and possible exemptions constituting the supplementary requirements for the student's admission.

Special requirements to access some programmes

Teaching method

While some courses are taught in large auditoriums, small groups are preferred for learning activities in language courses (particularly for practical work, language laboratories and work in computer rooms). For German, Dutch and Spanish language courses, students are placed in groups according to their level in order to provide a favourable environment for written and oral expression. Our teaching staff are there to create an opportunity for full language immersion.

Methodological assistance

Beginning in the first term of year 1, students will have the opportunity to familiarise themselves with university work. The Academic Guidance Service (AGS) offers a range of activities such as peer support, tutorials and revision period support. The programmes for these activities are available on the [AGS webpage](https://uclouvain.be/fr/sites/saint-louis-bruxelles/conseils-et-accompagnement.html) (<https://uclouvain.be/fr/sites/saint-louis-bruxelles/conseils-et-accompagnement.html>).

Evaluation

The evaluation methods comply with the regulations concerning studies and exams (<https://uclouvain.be/fr/decouvrir/rgeee.html>). More detailed explanation of the modalities specific to each learning unit are available on their description sheets under the heading "Learning outcomes evaluation method".

Assessment methods comply with the general regulations concerning studies and exams and are adapted to the course objectives. Assessments can take the form of a traditional written exam, an oral exam or written assignments. Further information on the specific assessment methods may be found in the course descriptions, under the heading 'Assessment methods'.

Three examination sessions are organised during the academic year, in January, June and August/September. First-year students who do not achieve passing grades in the January session may retake examinations in June and/or September.

Mobility and/or Internationalisation outlook

Exchange at another university

Cultural immersion activities are an integral part of the translation and interpretation programme. An exchange is equivalent to one term (25 credits). Three types of exchange are available:

- **Erasmus exchanges** with universities in European Union countries
- **Erasmus Belgica exchanges** with Dutch-language Belgian universities
- **exchanges with universities outside Europe.**

Language study grants

The university also awards [grants](#) to students for language courses in various destinations during the summer. The selection of candidates is based on motivation and the quality of their project. To qualify for a grant, students must have passed all of their exams in the first session.
