# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS – MASTER'S

---

## 1: General admission requirement

A relevant Bachelor's degree equivalent to a Danish Bachelor's degree in length and level (120 ECTS).

## 2: Specific admission requirements

Typically 60 to 90 ECTS within specific subject areas

## 3: English language requirement

A test recognised by AU such as TOEFL or IELTS\*

*\*Exemptions apply*

# CAREER WORKING IN DENMARK

## During your studies

Excellent career services tailored for international students

Work part-time for 20 hours or more per week

## After graduation

Stay for 2 year or more after graduation to find work

Low unemployment (2.3%)

High starting salaries (4700+ Euro/month)
