



She continued as an FNRS research associate at CORE from 1985 to 1995. She got a professorship at the University of Cergy in 1995 and, later, in 2003, at the University of Paris-Dauphine.

Françoise has a fantastic research record and, to cite Sylvain Sorin, "Françoise had a mission: to **transmit knowledge**, to **offer explanation**, to **construct examples**, to **give alternative approaches**, to propose **various proofs**, to suggest multiple interpretations, to present different links, to justify further connections."

It was a great conference with the participation of some great names, Roger Meyerson and Ehud Kalai, just to mention two names. Several CORE members were also present at the conference, **Claude d'Aspremont**, **Pierre Dehez**, **Ana Mauleon** and **Vincent Vannetelbosch**.


