#### Call for papers

Contributions are now being invited. Each submission consists of a *one page abstract* of the contribution and must be headed with the title, the names and affiliations of the authors, and the complete mailing address (including electronic mail address) of the corresponding author. We use web based on-line *electronic submissions* of contributed abstracts. The electronic submission procedure consists of filling out the electronic [Submission Form](#). For *each* contributed abstract this form **must** be completed and submitted electronically. Abstracts are uploaded with the [Submission Form](#).

#### **Only electronic submissions are accepted.**

Details for the preparation of the abstracts can be found in the [Authors' Kit](#). We strongly suggest following the instructions on that page. We emphasize that for **all** contributed abstracts, the [Submission Form](#) must be filled out to make your submission formal.

The deadline for receipt of contributed abstracts is

January 20, 2016

Proposals for Special Sessions consisting of four or five lectures centered around a specific topic are also solicited. Special Session Proposals should be send by email to [m.lazar@tue.nl](mailto:m.lazar@tue.nl). Each individual abstract in a Special Session proposal **must** be submitted via completion of the [Submission Form](#).

Decisions on the conference program will be made by the [Organizing Committee](#). Authors will be notified about the acceptance of their abstract on or before February 1, 2016. Final versions of the abstracts, if necessary, are due February 24, 2016. Abstracts will be included in a "Book of Abstracts" which will be distributed at the conference and will also be available on the web.

### Advance Program

The advance program of the Benelux Meeting will not be mailed. It will be made available electronically on the website as of March 15, 2016.

### Best Junior Presentation Award

Continuing a tradition that started in 1996, the Benelux meeting will again include a competition for the [Best Young Presenter Award](#).

In the unlikely event the conference centre accommodation reservations we have booked for our meeting are fully booked we will assign participants to other locations of comparable quality. If you register for a shared room (2 persons) and you want to share with a colleague from your group, then register for a *Shared room* and put the name of your colleague in the final comments section of the registration form. Important: Your colleague with whom you share the room also needs to register separately (!) using the registration form. There will be separate rooms for males and females.

On-line registrations received after March 10, 2016, will be processed using the on-site rate and **only** if space can be found. On-site registrations can be made at the conference registration desk if space is still available. Registration by fax, email or letters will **not** be accepted. The deadline for early registrations will be strictly adhered to. The registration fee includes:

- Admission to all sessions.
- A copy of the Book of Abstracts.
- Coffee, tea, ice water, and mints during the meeting.
- In the case of an *accommodation arrangement*: lunch and dinner on Tuesday; breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Wednesday; and breakfast and lunch on Thursday.
- In the case of an *only meals* arrangement: lunch on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
- In the case of a *one day* arrangement: lunch on Tuesday or Wednesday, or Thursday.
