Aims

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

develop a critical viewpoint of mediation based on an analysis of mediation models,

practices and theories;

analyse mediation measures (new measures relating to collective decisions and conflict

resolution);

use methodological tools to address certain present day issues of communications and the regulation of organisation critically.

Main themes

To situate mediation in the broader framework of a change in how our developed societies are socially regulated.

To know about the various areas of mediation, and organisational sectors in particular.

To differentiate between the main mediation models, and for each one, to identify specific critique of the adjudication, a social bond theory and a normative conception of justice.

To analyse measures of mediation.

To measure the contribution of pragmatic theories to mediation.
