#### Aims

Give a theoretical and practical (hands-on) introduction to corpus linguistics.

#### Main themes

The seminar gives an overall introduction to the field of corpus linguistics, which can be defined as the computerized study of language on the basis of electronic text collections. The following points will be covered: objectives and methods of corpus linguistics; corpus typology (written vs spoken; monolingual vs bilingual; etc.); corpus-based studies of lexis, grammar and discourse; software tools for the analysis of electronic texts (concordancers; part-of-speech taggers; parsers; error editors; etc.).
