Aims

The course aims to enable the student to function in the relevant social and professional contexts (cross-cultural understanding, socializing, telephoning, negotiating, presenting).

MAIN THEMES

Classroom activities simulate real-life situations which call on speaking skills (meetings, job interviews, telephone conversations, talks on working conditions) and, to a lesser extent, writing (an e-mail, a letter of application, a CV, etc).

CONTENT

The course aims at developing the communication techniques appropriate to professional life as well as improving command of the language (general and specific vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation).

TEACHING METHODS

- Mandatory placement test at the first class
- Interactive communication through classroom activities.
- Exposure to a variety of real-life situations requiring specific language functions.
- Consolidation and improvement of grammar use, vocabulary accuracy as well as pronunciation.
- Regular feedback on the student's oral production.
