The syllabus involves all aspects of commercial law and principally considers the following themes (the emphasis placed on any one topic may vary ):

- history of commercial law
  - characteristics and specific features of modern commercial law
  - specific domains
  - institutions
  - aims of modern trade law
  - legal forms of companies
  - company assets
  - financing of companies
  - company contracts
  - rules applicable to company activities
  - transfer of companies
- Commercial law concepts, institutions and rules are always presented from a historical, economic, comparative and European perspective.
