#### Aims

This course belongs to the group of critical courses aiming at complementing the technical education offered to our graduate students with a more philosophical, methodological and historical reflection. It should help students to get a broader perspective in an age of specialization and emphasis on technical skills.

A student having taken the course should master the conceptual bases of social choice theory or of contemporary ethics and political philosophy, depending on the focus of the course.

#### Main themes

The course reviews recent developments either in contemporary ethics and political philosophy or in the formal theory of social choice.
