Aims

To teach the student how :1 $^{\circ}$ to seize the philosophical conceptions founding the major educational options; 2° to draw and to criticize the conceptions of man conveyed by contemporary human sciences (particularly educational sciences); 3° to understand the specificity of human sciences (particularly educational sciences) and their links with other forms of know-how and with practice.
