Aims

Provide a foundation course in Dutch phonetics, phonology and morphology. The students should also be able to analyse reference books with a criticizing mind.

Main themes

- 1. The course covers two linguistics fields: Dutch phonetics and phonology, and Dutch morphology.
- 2. Introduction to the reading (and writing) of scientific articles.
- 3. Presentation of reference books.

Content and teaching methods

The course is an introduction to Dutch phonetics, phonology and morphology.

Phonetics and phonology (vowels, diphthongs, consonants; co-articulation; accentuation and intonation).

Morphology (inflection and derivation).

Other information (prerequisite, evaluation (assessment methods), course materials recommended readings, ...)

Prerequisite: GERM 1133.

Assessment: written and oral exam (+ essay).
