



GERM1523 Introduction to English linguistics: syntax and stylistics

#### Aims

Provide a foundation course in English syntax and stylistics and train students in the reading and writing of scientific articles in these two fields.

### **Main themes**

The course covers the following two linguistic fields:

- 1. Syntax: grammatical categories; syntactic and semantic functions; phrases; simple, complex and compound sentences.
- 2. Stylistics: analysis of the lexical and syntactic differences between different varieties of English (speech vs writing; formal vs informal style).

## Content and teaching methods

This course provides a solid foundation in English syntax and stylistics via lectures and exercise sessions as well as training in the reading and writing of scientific articles in these two fields.
