- cognitive trends (3H)
- reading and spelling exercises for reeducation (FDE 15H)
- role-playing (5H)
- dyscalculias (BP 5H)

Content and teaching methods

1. Written language

- Analysis of clinical cases, familiarisation with the main diagnosis and reeducation tools for dyslexia, dysorthographies and disorders of written understanding.
