Aims

To provide students with opportunities to progressively practice their management of teaching situations.
 To provide students with opportunities to work on possible difficulties met during the first internship periods

Main themes

Each student will take part (as a student, a teacher or an observer) to:

- o short exercises (10 to 15 min.)
 - o performed in front of a small group of students (6 to 8)
 - o focused on the realisation of some targeted pedagogical skills (e.g. :
 introducing and making aware of a lesson content, mastering verbal skills, using non-verbal language, checking the understanding through questioning, stimulating and regulating verbal exchanges, making concepts more practical through the use of examples, using visual aids (tables, posters..)).
- The video recording of the sequences will emphasize the trainees' autoscropy, and allow auto-analysis of the trials.

Other information (prerequisite, evaluation (assessment methods), course materials recommended readings, ...)

Exercises will take place in groups of 10 students.
 Condition : to be registered at the program PSP2A
 The evaluation is essentially formative.
 The certificative evaluation lies on the active attendance to the various roles required by the method and on an individual written integrative synthesis.
