Main themes

These objectives will be achieved after a presentation of:

- old Jewish literature texts (Qumran, Pseudepigraphs, Targums, Midrash, Mishna, Talmuds)
- the historical context in which this literature was produced
- rabbinic text interpretation methods.

Content and teaching methods

We begin with a summary of Jewish history (from 589 BC to 135 AD), and go on presenting old Jewish literature from a biblical point of view (...)

Special attention will be drawn towards rabbinic text interpretation methods.
