Aims

Listening comprehension

Individual : à Ability to understand oral speech in informal situations and in mass-media provided that a student has time to get familiar with specific vocabulary and specific mode of pronunciation.àAbility to comprehend audiovisual authentic materials.

Interactive :à Ability to follow the conversation of several speakers on familiar topic. Level B2 of " Common European Framework of Reference for Languages"

Oral speech

Individualà Ability to make presentations on topics connected with everyday life occasionally referring to written notes.

Interactive :à Ability to take part in the conversations without preparation on topics connected with everyday life. à Ability to actively participate in the conversations on familiar topics and support one's opinion. Level B2 of " Common European Framework of Reference for Languages"

Code

Intermediate level of linguistic competence with grammar structures(simple and complex), vocabulary (general and specific), Russian pronunciation necessary for successful communication.
