Aims

To strengthen the understanding of principles and elaborate methodologies specific to biomedical ethics.

Main themes

- 1. The content of this seminar is provided by the annual theme of research of the bioethics Center EBIM. The themes treated are for instance: medical applications of genetics and its ethical impact, human experimentation end of life, assisted reproduction.
