The main aim of this receptive course is to develop students' reading skills.

Reading comprehension

At the end of the course, the students should be able to:- grasp the content and significance of articles and reports on topics connected with their interests or their jobs.- summarise the main ideas of these texts.

- (1) reinforcement of basic vocabulary + (general and medical) vocabulary building
- (2) grammatical and lexical difficulties

Main themes

The texts chosen will introduce students to a wide variety of topics of interest to students of Hospital Management.

- tenses (active and passive voices)
- modal auxiliaries
- compounds
- false friends
- prepositions
- link words
