Aims

- to give the students the opportunity to concretely experiment the functioning of a work team (to perceive and analyse the various processes and components of the group dynamics)
- to observe his/her own behaviour inside this group and to develop efficient behaviours of team work; to understand more thoroughly and to be able to apply in real situations the conceptual frames presented in the prerequisite courses; to concretely experiment the modes of intervention and of training used in the companies and organisations.

Main themes

- group phenomena: socio-affective and socio-operatory dynamics, leadership and influence, conflicts and group structuration, treatment of the information and decision making,...
- interpersonal communication, personal attitudes in a group and their effects on the team work, risks and uncertainties inside the groups, ...
- organisation of the team work, team building, meeting leading,...

Content and teaching methods
