The program committee is soliciting papers describing original work (work under review elsewhere can be submitted provided overlap with simultaneously submitted papers is clearly documented).

Prospective authors are encouraged to submit a **one-page abstract in pdf format** (including names, affiliations and email addresses of the authors), by sending an e-mail to **sitb2016@uclouvain.be**

Each accepted paper will lead either to an oral presentation with discussion or to a poster presentation. The symposium will have on-line proceedings with a separate ISBN, and will feature a Best Student Presentation award.

Early submissions (first three abstracts) will be rewarded. A limited number of grants will be made available to MSc students who have an accepted paper at the symposium (see web site for details).
